2009 Catholic Service and Ministry Appeal

As of July 22, we have received pledges amounting to \$1,122,743 from 7,212 households for an average gift of \$155.68. We are at 64% of our overall goal of \$1.75M. Last year we were at 79% of our goal at this time with 10,001 households pledging their support in the amount of \$1,384,123.
