Jesus the Ordinary

How human do we think Jesus is? Is he like us? Is he *ordinary*?

Our anthropologies - our views of what it means to be human - both make possible and limit our ways of understanding Jesus.

By examining scripture, different historical eras, the nature of creedal statements, and contemporary images of Jesus, this workshop will explore how we can deepen our understanding of Christ and our own humanness.

Daniel Finucane, Ph.D. teaches in the Department of Theological Studies at Saint Louis University, and is the director of SLU's Manresa Program in Catholic, Jesuit Studies.
