ILLINOIS CONFERENCE OF CHURCHES ANNOUNCES POVERTY SUMMIT ON MARCH 11-12, 2011 AT THE NATIONAL SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF THE SNOWS, BELLEVILLE, ILLINOIS

SPRINGFIELD, IL, USA – February 1, 2011 – The Illinois Conference of Churches announces a poverty summit to bring together those who work with Illinois individuals and families struggling during the economic downturn.

Reverend Peg Chamberlin, President of the National Council of Churches and Executive Director of the Minnesota Council of Churches, will make the opening address and will also lead a Bible-based poverty study titled *“Is God Really on the Side of the Poor?”*

Amy Terpstra, Associate Director of the Social IMPACT Center, a program Heartland Alliance, will discuss the faces of poverty in Illinois.

The Reverend Donald E. Mason Ecumenical Award for Christian Unity will be presented at the award banquet that evening, followed by a concert given by the internationally acclaimed Rev. Mike Rayson.

Organizations such as Churches United of the Quad City Area (Illinois/Iowa), Good Samaritan Ministries (Carbondale), Dove, Inc. (Decatur), BEACON Ministry (Belleville), and Catholic Urban Programs (East St. Louis), will be presenting information about their services and how to begin collaboration with other agencies.
