



International World Youth Day Pilgrimage

Madrid, Spain - August 10-22, 2011

International World Youth Day Pilgrimage is an opportunity to celebrate our Catholic faith with the Holy Father and the youth of the world! This pilgrimage trip is a service of the Office of Youth Ministry, Diocese of Belleville.

International World Youth Day events are for youth, young adults and adult chaperones. All youth must be a minimum of 16 at the time of the trip or be accompanied by a parent or guardian in order to participate. High school students must be under the supervision of an adult chaperone. We strongly encourage young adults between 18 and 35 years of age to register because the International World Youth Day events target older pilgrims in content and vision.

COST (subject to change)

- Estimated cost is \$3,650.00 per person which includes:
- Days in the Diocese (*an opportunity to spend 3 days within a host diocese within Spain while living with local host families*)
- Hotel lodging with 2-3 persons per room
- Round trip airfare from St. Louis to include airport taxes and fees
- Public transportation while in Madrid
- Airport transfers
- International World Youth Day registration fee
- Farewell dinner in Madrid on August 21, 2011
- Pilgrimage guide assistance provided by travel agency

Above fees do not include passport or visa fees, gratuities and some meals.

We anticipate an initial deposit of \$400.00 per person by **January 15, 2010** to reserve your place. A payment plan for subsequent payments will be established and provided upon registration.
